

Laser Comb to present Clinical Data to FDA

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New Research

Clinical trials began in April and the company has now passed the very important three-month mark. Results to this point are extremely encouraging. The trials should be completed and the results submitted to the FDA in the early spring.

The HairMax LaserComb is a Low-Level Laser, which complies with FDA laser safety requirements and is currently marketed as a cosmetic device capable of producing thicker, shinier and healthier hair.

Nationally and internationally there is a great amount of enthusiasm for the potential of low-level laser for hair. Lexington International had its beginnings in Sydney, Australia where a prototype of the

LaserComb was developed. The company moved its headquarters to Boca Raton on Florida's Internet Coast in 2000, where the HairMax LaserComb is also manufactured.
